## **DETAILS OF TRAINING**

Do you have a structured residency or fellowship program? Yes, The institute runs a 3 year DM Nephrology programme. 6 candidates are selected every year through a national examination. These candidates have completed their residency in Internal Medicine. During their training they are rotated through nephrology ward services, hemodialysis, peritoneal dialysis and transplant services. The department started its CAPD programme in 1993 and is one of the largest CAPD centres in India and South Asia The institution has been providing training in PD including catheter insertion to trainees from India and abroad. Trainees from abroad have come from Vietnam and Nepal. This training programme is for 6-12 weeks depending on the trainees needs and during this programme they have a teaching session for 5 hours every week and practical and hands-on training for 36 hours every week
