Do you have a structured residency or fellowship program? Yes, we regularly mentor ISPD, ISN and other fellows on government or professional society scholarships for the purpose of providing PD and/or home-based dialysis (PD and Home HD) training. We provide PD clinical training (clinics, ambulatory PD care, inpatient ward rounds), PD clinical research training (statistical training sessions, ANZDATA Registry projects, clinical trial design, conduct and analysis through the Australasian Kidney Trials Network), peer support (through the BEAT-CKD early career researcher network) and weekly teaching/education sessions (medical grand rounds, renal biopsy meetings, department lunchtime education sessions, journal club meetings, research meetings). Fellows are provided with office, desk, computer and other infrastructural support.
